What is this?

This info-mural is part of an ongoing project we have been conducting at Stanford University. The project has focused on creating a comprehensive set of info-murals that represent the social, political and economic views of a country. The infomurals are each approx 5 feet by 15 feet in size and contain hundreds of data elements, diagrams, and other visual elements.

What does it contain?

This "Chin's Rightful Place in the World" is a brief history of China shown graphically in four of the five bright yelloworange arrows. The mural then speculates about the plausible future of China through 2050. The project was undertaken in 2007, and as you can see, China has accomplished becoming the second largest economy in the world as our scenario suggests.
